including shielding them from scammers who target vulnerable individuals or close family members that have been known to go after cash if they think it's easy to get.

Here are some ways you can help to protect your family:

Get a Power of Attorney. A Power of Attorney is a legal document that appoints someone to manage affairs if a person becomes unable to. With a Power of Attorney, you can choose someone who is trustworthy to handle your aging parents' or grandparents' finances and may be a good option to ensure their money is handled properly. There are different types of Powers of Attorney and other options like a living trust. Consult an estate planner to help decide what's best.

Talk with your family. Talk with your elderly family members about their finances and confirm what they want done with their money. It's best to involve other relevant family members and establish a plan together. This ensures everyone is on the same page avoiding any disputes later on.

Watch for scams. The elderly are popular targets by criminals who think they can take advantage of vulnerable individuals. Keep an eye out and remind aging family members to not give any personal information to a stranger including Social Security number, account numbers, personal identification numbers (PINs), or bank account login information.


